To help ensure an enjoyable visit, please be aware of the following:

1. Register and pay for your site within 30 minutes after arrival. If you plan to stay additional nights, pay by 2:00 pm each day following. **Check out time is 2:00 PM.**
2. **Reservations** may be made by contacting the National Recreation Reservation System toll free at (877) 444-6777 or online www.recreation.gov. All other campsites are on a **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS**.
3. Site **MUST** be occupied first night and not left vacant for more than 24 hours thereafter. Camping equipment must occupy site at time of payment.
4. The **Federal Interagency Senior/Access Pass** may be used only by the person to whom they are issued. Pass holders may pay for only one site and must occupy that site under their passport. Other sites will be at the regular price.
5. Motorbikes, motorcycles, or other motor vehicles are to be used on designated road ways and camping spurs within the campground.
6. Trailers and vehicles **must have all wheels on the spur**. Trailers may be parked on some tent pads. Two vehicles per site, space permitting. Parking is not permitted on unoccupied sites, along roads, nor on the grass.
7. Bicycles may not be ridden after dark.
8. Each campsite is limited to only one family, or group of 8 persons, and must include at least one person 18 years of age or older.
9. No more than 2 tents (or 1 R.V. and 1 tent) may be on the ground at any one site.
10. Pets must be on a leash or in a cage. Please do not bring pets into restrooms. Please clean up after your pet.
11. Campfires are permitted in grills as provided. Dead wood from ground may be used for firewood. Do not cut vegetation or standing trees.
12. Prepare food, wash dishes and clean fish at your campsite only, not in the restroom or at the hydrants.
13. **Quiet hours will be observed from 10:00pm to 7:00am.** Generators may run a maximum of 4 hours and only between the hours of 7am and 7pm and only for the purpose of charging batteries.
14. Do not leave hoses hooked up to water hydrants. Do not run electric cords to restrooms unless authorized by management.
15. Discharge of firearms and fireworks (including air rifles, dart guns, and bow & arrow) are prohibited in the campground area.
16. You may change campsites only ONCE during your stay.
