# Indian-Celina Lake Recreation Area

The Indian and Celina Recreation Area is a tranquil get-away in the midst of the Hoosier National Forest. The recreation area contains Celina Lake (164 ac.) and Indian Lake (152 ac.). It is located 3 miles south of Interstate 64 off State Highway 37. The recreation area offers camping, electric motor boating, fishing, and hiking.

This area is operated by a concessionaire who leases the area from the US Forest Service. Fees and dates are subject to change. Fees may be reduced or waived during low use seasons or fall hunting season.

**Camping:** Indian-Celina includes 63 individual sites divided into two loops. Each loop contains centralized water, flush toilets, hot showers, and a recharge table for electric boat motors. A selection of single or extra large, electric or non-electric sites are available in this shady campground.

The campground is open with full services from April 1 to October 15. North Face Loop is open year-round though there are no showers between 10/16 and 3/30 and only vault toilets. South Slope Loop is open with reduced service until the end of firearm gun season. A maximum of 2 vehicles and 8 persons are allowed in single sites and 4 vehicles and 16 persons in double sites. An additional \$5/vehicle per day fee is charged for anything beyond the first vehicle in a single site or 2 vehicles in a double site. Campsites must be occupied every night. Some sites may be reserved by calling the reservation number below. A reservation fee of \$10 is charged. Reservation information is on the back page. Camping sites may be reserved from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Camping is otherwise available on a first come basis.

**Camping Fees:** \$22/night for a family site with electric, or \$17 without electric. Double sites are \$38/site with electric or \$31 without. If more than a single vehicle is present (or 2 vehicles for double sites), an additional \$5/vehicle per day is charged. Senior and Access passport holders receive a discount on campsite fees. From October 16 through January 7, services and camping fees are reduced.

**Day Use Fees:** A \$5/vehicle (4/1-10/15) parking fee is charged, except for campground occupants. An annual pass is available at the gate for \$35. All parking areas and the boat ramps are open year-round.

**Picnic Sites:** Picnic tables are provided near the boat ramp on the shore of Indian Lake and at the Rickenbaugh House site.

**Boating and Fishing:** Indian and Celina Lakes are two of four fishing lakes along State Highway 37. Only electric motors are allowed to maintain the tranquility of the area. These lakes offer many miles of shoreline and coves for fishing for pan fish. Boat ramps are open year-round. An accessible fishing pier is available on Celina Lake.

**Trails:** *Rickenbaugh Interpretive Trail* (1 mile): This trail is located behind the historic Rickenbaugh House. It is an easy 30 minute walk.

*Two Lakes Loop National Recreation Trail* (16 miles): This trail encircles both Indian and Celina Lakes and winds through many acres of natural and peaceful forests. Spur trails (marked in orange) access the main trail (marked in white) to offer short, day hikes. Much of this trail is on steep slopes, hiking half could take 4-5 hours.

**The Historic Rickenbaugh House and Cemetery:** This sandstone block house was built in 1874. The house is open periodically during the summer months when staff is available. A separate information sheet on the history of the Rickenbaugh House is available.

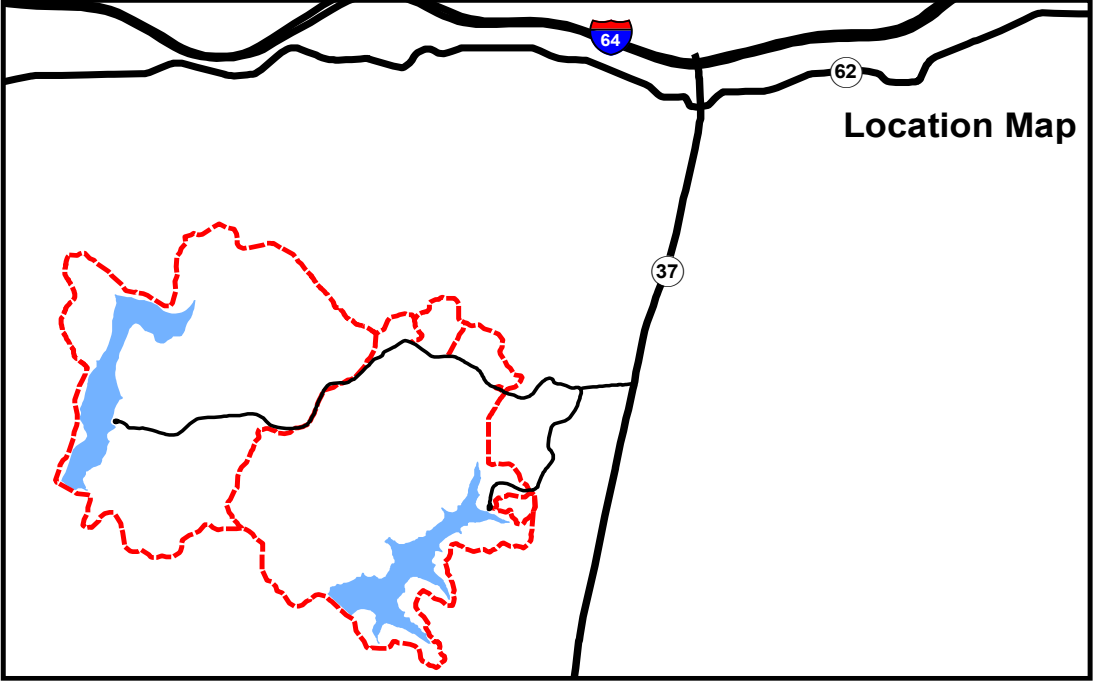
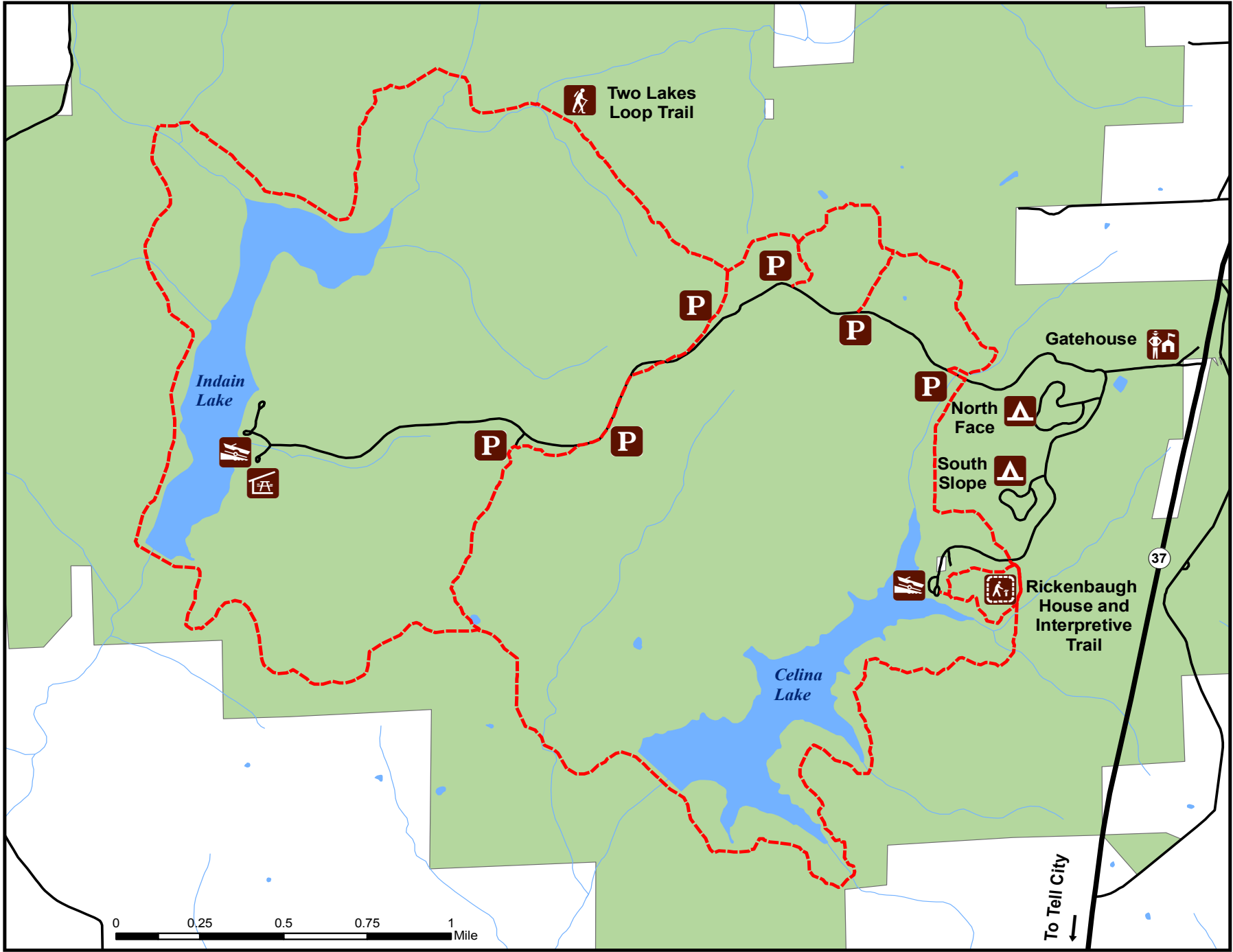

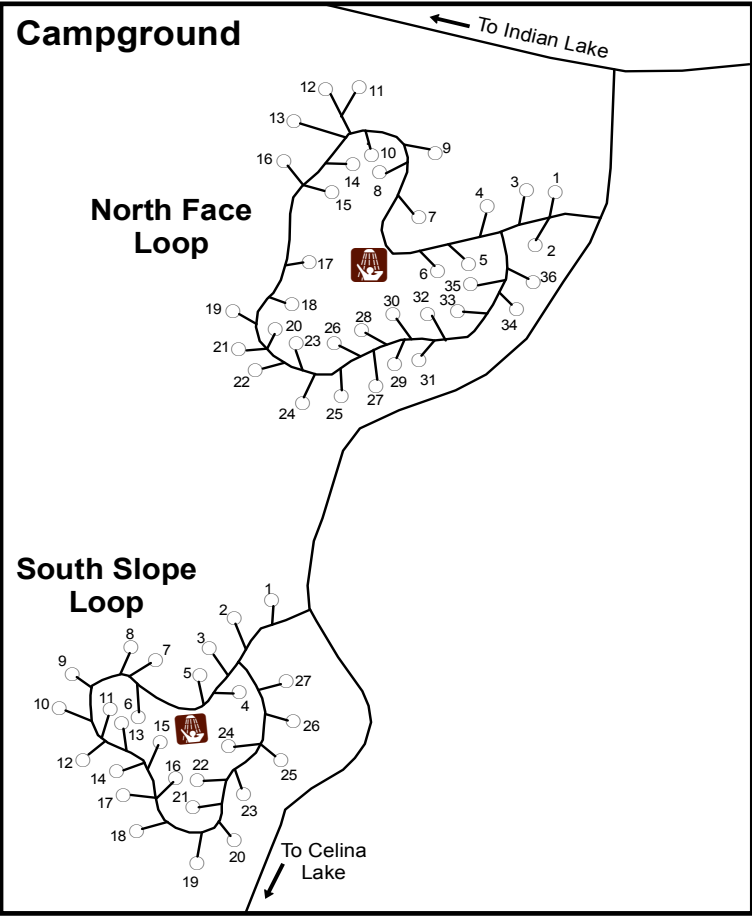
