

Speed Limit Observe the **15 MPH speed limit** and **all traffic signs**. Bicycles should not be ridden after dark. All vehicles must conform to NC Laws.

Campers must be at least **18 years old** to rent a site and are responsible for the activities of the site. Camp sites must be occupied the first night.

RV Water tanks must be filled at potable water station near dump station (excludes FHU sites). Do **NOT** connect host to water hydrant in loops. This is prohibited by NC State Law.

Check-out time is **12 Noon**. Renew your site by **10 AM**.

Lake Powhatan Recreation Area is open and fees are collected March 1 to November 30. Stay limits are 14 days within 30 days. The stay limit is cumulative and includes the following campgrounds; Lake Powhatan, North Mills River, Sunburst, and Davidson River.

Reservations must be made by the National Recreation Reservation System at **1-877-444-6777** or online www.recreation.gov. Reservations must be made at least 4 days in advance.

Refunds may be made only for emergency situations. No refunds are given for weather. Refund requests for reserved sites are handled by Customer Service at the National Recreation Reservation Service. See contact information listed above.

The Federal Interagency Pass (Senior and Access) may be used only by the person to whom they are issued, for single sites. Pass holder must occupy the site.

Weapons and fireworks cannot be discharged in the campground. Possession of firearms must conform to the NC State Law.

Lost and Found items are turned in to the staff. If unclaimed, they are donated to a charity or disposed of properly.

Lake Beach area closed **8 PM to 10 AM**. No floatation devices allowed in lake.

Vehicles & RVs must back onto site with wheels on pavement or gravel parking spur. Parking is not permitted on the grass, along any roads or in vacant sites.

Tents must be kept within gravel area of campsite.

Single Camp Sites allow up to 8 people, 2 vehicles and 1 wheeled camper.

Double Sites allow up to 16 people, 4 vehicles and 2 wheeled campers.

Additional cars will be charged an additional daily fee of \$5.00.

Campfires are permitted ONLY in the fire rings. Removal of any tree or branch (live or dead) or other vegetation is prohibited. "Dead & Down" wood may be used for firewood.

Prepare food, wash dishes and clean fish at campsites only, **NOT** at bathhouses or hydrants. Water hydrants are NOT connected to sewer system.

Generators may be used up to **4** hours a day between the hours of **8 AM to 8 PM**.

Quiet hours will be observed from **10 PM to 7 AM**. Please be considerate and respectful of other campers.

Visitors All visitors must obtain a hang tag at the gatehouse when entering and are requested to return it to the gatehouse when leaving. **All visitors must leave by 9 PM. The gate will close at 10 PM.**

Pets must be on a leash or caged at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended anywhere in the park and are not permitted in bathrooms. **Please clean up after your pet.**

Gatehouse is open from **7 AM to 10 PM**.
