North Mills River Recreation Area is open year round. Stay limits are 14 days within 30 days between April 1 – October 31. Stay limits are 30 days from November 1 – March 31. The stay limit is cumulative and includes the following campgrounds: Lake Powhatan, North Mills River, Sunburst, and Davidson River.

Reservations may be made by contacting the National Recreation Reservation Service at 1-877-444-6777 or online at www.recreation.gov. Reservations must be made at least 4 days in advance of arrival date.

Refunds may be made only for emergency situations. No refunds are given for weather. Refund requests for reserved sites are handled by Customer Service at the National Recreation Reservation Service. See contact information listed above.

Federal Interagency Passes (Senior and Access) may be used only by the person to whom they are issued, for single sites (excludes Double and Group Sites). The pass holder must occupy the site.

Campers must be at least **18 years old** to rent a site and are responsible for the activities of the site. Camp sites must be occupied the first night.

Check Out time is **12 NOON**. Renew by **10 AM**.

Speed Limit--Observe the **15 MPH speed limit** and **all traffic signs**. All vehicles must conform to NC Law.

Vehicles/ RVs & Tents must be kept within gravel area of campsite. Vehicles must have all wheels on pavement or gravel. Parking is not permitted on the grass, along the road or in vacant sites.

Single Camp Sites allow up to 8 people, 2 vehicles and 1 wheeled camper.

Double Camp Sites allow up to 16 people, 4 vehicles and 2 wheeled campers.

Additional cars will be charged a daily fee. If they do not fit on pavement of the site, they must be moved to overflow parking.

Campfires are permitted ONLY in fire rings. Removal of any tree, branch, or other vegetation (live or dead) is prohibited. "Dead and Down" wood may be used for firewood.

Prepare food, wash dishes and clean fish at campsites only, **NOT** at bathhouses or hydrants. Water hydrants are NOT connected to sewer system.

Generators may be used up to **4** hours between the hours of **8 AM and 8 PM**.

Quiet hours will be observed from 10PM to 7AM. Be considerate of other campers.

Pets must be on a leash or caged at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended in the campground and are not permitted in the bathrooms. **Clean up after your pet.**

Weapons and Fireworks cannot be discharged in the campground. Possession of firearms must conform to NC State Law.

Lost and Found items are turned in to the staff. If unclaimed, they are donated to a charity or disposed of properly. See manager for details.
