Sunburst Recreation Area is open from April to October 31. Stay limits are 14 days within 30 days. The stay limit is cumulative and includes the following campgrounds: Lake Powhatan, North Mills River, Sunburst, and Davidson River.

The Federal Interagency Senior/Access Pass may be used only by the person to whom they are issued, for one single site. Pass holder must occupy the site.

Campers must be at least 18 years old to rent a site and are responsible for the activities at the site. Camp sites must be occupied the first night.

Check Out time is **12 NOON**. Please RENEW by 10 AM.

Speed Limit Please observe the **15 MPH speed limit** and all traffic signs. All vehicles must conform to NC State Laws.

Vehicles, RVs and Tents must be on the pavement or gravel surface. Camping equipment should be kept on camp site. Vehicles must have all wheels on the pavement or gravel. Parking is not permitted on the grass, along the road or in vacant sites.

Single Camp Sites allow up to 8 people and 2 vehicles.

Double Camp Sites allow up to 16 people and 4 vehicles.

Additional Cars will be charged additional fee, and must be parked in an overflow parking area.

Campfires are permitted ONLY in the fire rings. "Dead & Down" wood may be used for firewood. Removal of any tree limb or branch (live or dead) or other vegetation is prohibited.

Prepare food, wash dishes and clean fish at campsites only, not in restrooms, at hydrants, or in bathrooms.

Generators may be used up to 4 hours a day between the hours of 8 AM to 8 PM. Generators may NOT be used at night.

Quiet hours will be observed from 10PM to 7AM. Be considerate of other campers.

Pets must be on a leash or in a cage at all times. Please clean up after your pets. Pets are NOT to be left unattended in the campground and are not permitted in bathrooms.

Weapons and fireworks cannot be discharged in the campground. Possession of firearms must conform to NC State Laws.

Garbage must be placed in dumpsters. Dumpsters are located throughout the campground.

Lost and found items are turned in to the staff. See Management for details.

Refunds may be made only in emergency situations. No refunds are given for weather.
